The most technically perfect medieval castle in Britain, Beaumaris was begun in 1295, in reaction to a Welsh rising, and stands commanding the old Ferry Crossing to Anglesey. Work progressed at an astonishing speed but funds and supplies faltered and after 30 years the Castle was still not complete. This magnificent white elephant is the most fascinating of Edward I's Castles to explore.

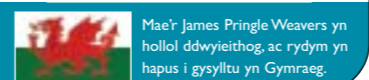
